
## **UNION AND HARMONY MEETING HOUSE (c. 1833)**

## 133 Edgewater Street, Mahone Bay



In 1833, trustees from four denominations – Baptist, Lutheran, Methodist and Presbyterian – came together in the building of the *Union and Harmony Meeting House* on Edgewater Street. "Union House" would serve as Mahone Bay's first *church*, long before the community became known for its iconic "3 Churches".







In subsequent years, after each faith had built their own church, Union House provided a home for 2 families as a "double house".

Today, Union House is a distinctive Single Family Home, ideally situated in arguably the most coveted location in popular Mahone Bay.
