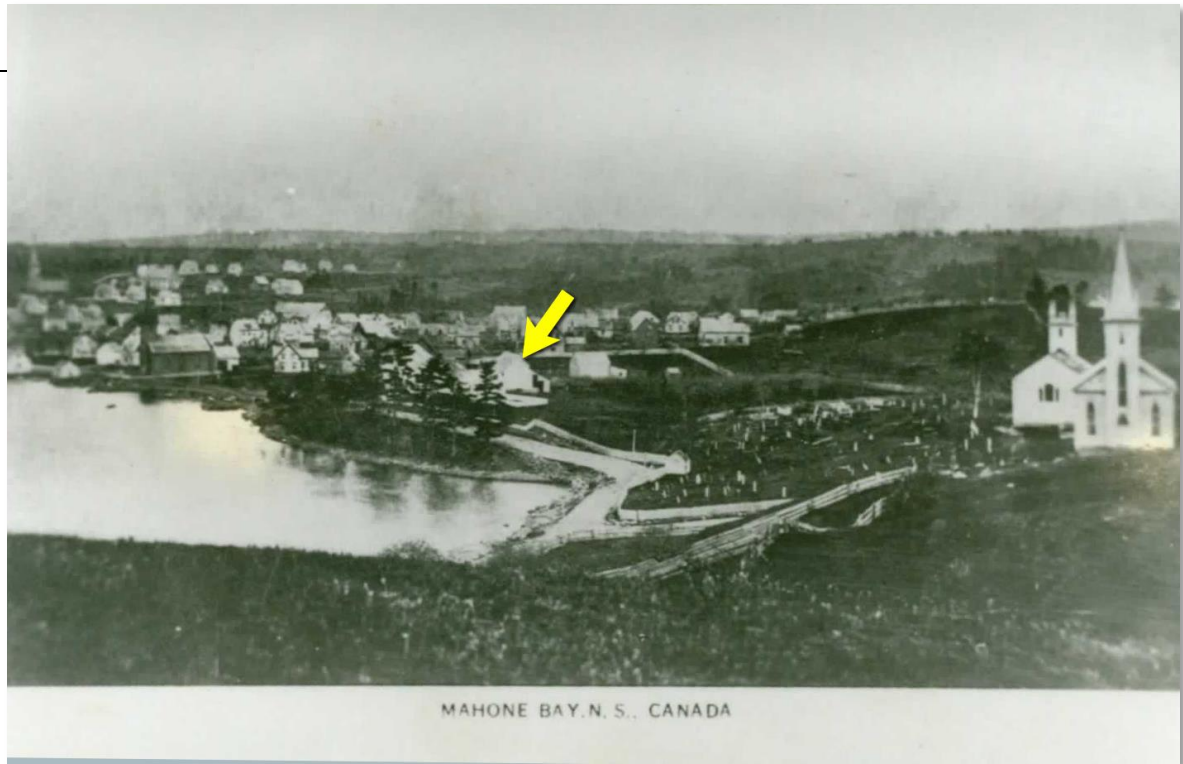


## UNION AND HARMONY MEETING HOUSE (c. 1833)

133 Edgewater Street, Mahone Bay



In 1833, trustees from four denominations – Baptist, Lutheran, Methodist and Presbyterian – came together in the building of the *Union and Harmony Meeting House* on Edgewater Street. “Union House” would serve as Mahone Bay’s first church, long before the community became known for its iconic “3 Churches”.



In subsequent years, after each faith had built their own church, Union House provided a home for 2 families as a “double house”.

Today, Union House is a distinctive Single Family Home, ideally situated in arguably the most coveted location in popular Mahone Bay.
