Lighthouse Cottage











Logistics of Tidal Security & Serenity



Nova Scotia's Bay of Fundy records the highest tides on the planet, averaging 45'-55' feet through the moon cycle. The tide rises and falls twice in every 24 hour period, pushing 115 billion tonnes of water in and out of the Bay with each pass. Except for a window of about 4 hours surrounding the high tides, Long Island is inaccessible by boat...a serene and secure geological fortress, engulfed by miles of sandy sea bed.

From the dock one ascends the 194 step stairwell running up a crevasse in the cliff side. In 2011 an incline elevator for passengers will be installed.









Getting to the Island

When the tide is out, the Island can be accessed by helicopter from Halifax International Airport. Flying time is about 30 minutes.






